Sign up by November 6th and Rabbi Alban will purchase all the necessary materials to be picked up by you on November 15th from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm.

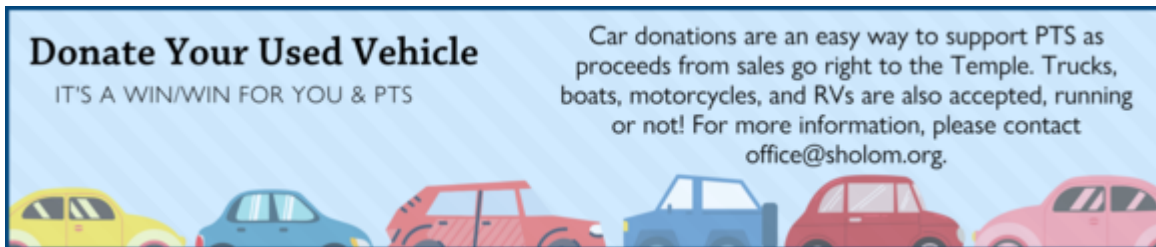
